ADR / PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

I have been appointed Arbitrator severally and have also acted as counsel in several arbitrations, advised parties and assisted parties file claim in domestic and International arbitration and also acted as a mediator. Below are some select cases I have dealt with.

AS ARBITRATOR

- Arbitrator in a water & sewerage facilities construction dispute between a Kenyan Company and a state corporation where a claim of approximately USD 8.46 Million was filed.
- Arbitrator in a project development and transfer agreement dispute between a university and an international private developer where a claim of

approximately USD 5.92 Million, together with interest and costs was made.

- Arbitrator in a claim for unlawful termination of employment and discrimination at the workplace by an employee against a multi-national shipping company where the claimant sought for statutory benefits, compensation and exemplary damages in a claim of about USD 893, 700.
